Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar University Agra recognizes poverty as a multidimensional challenge that extends beyond income deprivation, encompassing limited access to quality education, healthcare services, skill development opportunities, digital resources, and sustainable livelihood options.



Aligned with **SDG-1 (No Poverty)** the University adopts an inclusive framework integrating academic excellence with social responsibility and sustainable development. It views higher education as a transformative instrument for social mobility and economic empowerment.

The University ensures inclusive access through scholarships fee concessions and



financial assistance for SC ST OBC Minority and Economically Weaker Section students. Institutional support systems streamline government scholarship schemes reduce dropout risks and enable first-generation and rural learners to pursue higher education thereby breaking cycles of intergenerational poverty.

Academic mentoring remedial coaching and counselling strengthen retention and progression creating a supportive ecosystem for marginalized students. By combining financial aid with academic reinforcement the University promotes equitable participation and long-term employability.

Skill development and economic empowerment are central to its strategy. Career counselling placement assistance internships entrepreneurship awareness programs and digital literacy training enhance employability and encourage self-reliance. These initiatives translate education into tangible economic outcomes and contribute to local economic development.



Through NSS and extension activities the University engages in community outreach including volunteer teaching literacy promotion health awareness hygiene and sanitation campaigns and preventive healthcare initiatives. Legal literacy camps and awareness programs on welfare schemes strengthen social protection access participatory governance and grassroots empowerment.
