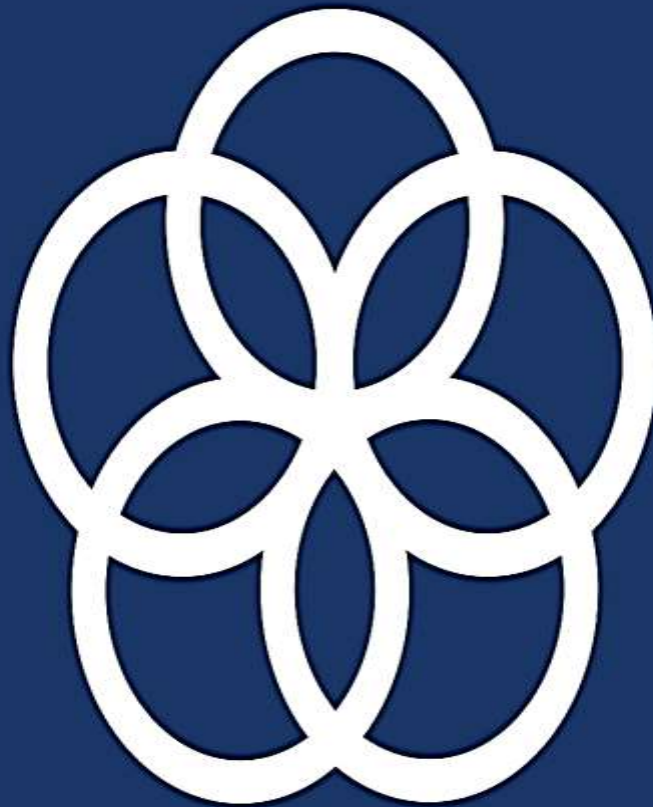

# **17 PARTNERSHIPS FOR THE GOALS**





Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Agra demonstrates a strong commitment towards Sustainable Development Goal 17 – Partnerships for the Goals by strengthening collaboration at local, national, and international levels to promote inclusive and sustainable development. The University actively builds partnerships with government bodies, civil society, private sector organizations, NGOs, industries, and academic and research institutions to equip students with the knowledge and skills required to address sustainable development challenges and to uphold the principle of “leaving no one behind”.

Through these expanded collaborations, the University integrates sustainability into education, research, innovation, and community engagement, thereby revitalizing global and regional partnerships for holistic development.

The University has undertaken several collaborative quality initiatives that reflect its proactive engagement in knowledge-sharing partnerships. A notable example is the webinar on “Strategies for Enhancing Research Collaborations in Chemical Sciences,” organized by the Department of Chemistry in collaboration with IQAC under the initiative of the Hon’ble Governor of Uttar Pradesh and Chancellor. The webinar highlighted the importance of collaborative research, shared ownership of results, extramural funding opportunities, and capacity building for young researchers. Such initiatives strengthen academic networks and enhance research productivity through institutional cooperation.

The poster is for a webinar titled "STRATEGIES FOR ENHANCING RESEARCH COLLABORATIONS IN CHEMICAL SCIENCES" organized by IQAC and the Department of Chemistry at Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Agra. It features three speakers: Prof. Nandana Singh (Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Purvanchal University, Gorakhpur), Prof. Anandiben Patel (Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Agra), and Prof. B.P. Singh (Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, MJP Rohilkhand University, Bareilly). The webinar is moderated by Prof. Sanjeet Kumar (Director, IQAC). The highlights of the webinar are: 1. How to collaborate more effectively, 2. Creating a collaborating Agreement and its associated benefits, and 3. Learn what it takes to be a good team player.

On the initiative of Honorable Governor of UP, Chancellor Dr. BhimRao Ambedkar University, Agra Mrs. Anandiben Patel, the Department of Chemistry and IQAC took a significant step towards organizing a webinar. Our Experts elucidated the nuances of successful collaboration, benefits of collaboration to young researchers for enhancing their writing skills, increase network opportunities for project development, extramural support in the thrust area and shared ownership of result and accountability.



Further strengthening national and international partnerships, the Department of Chemistry organized the XXXXI Annual Conference of the Indian Council of Chemists in collaboration with the Indian Council of Chemists, where more than 300 national and international delegates deliberated on developments in Physical, Inorganic, Organic, and Analytical Chemistry aligned with sustainable development goals. This large-scale academic collaboration fostered interdisciplinary dialogue and promoted scientific cooperation in sustainability-oriented research.

The University also promotes cultural and global academic partnerships. The Institute of Tourism and Hotel Management collaborated with Glamour Live Films, Mumbai, to organize an international film festival where 32 international films from 15 countries were screened, carrying strong social messages and promoting global awareness and responsibility.

Additionally, the Department of French organized an International Conference on “Francophonie et Littérature: état actuel” in collaboration with AITF, AIEQ, and Bureau du Québec, Mumbai, focusing on linguistic diversity, cultural cooperation, higher education, and research partnerships among countries

These initiatives illustrate the University’s efforts to build cross-cultural and international academic linkages.

In the domain of skill development and industry-academia collaboration, the Dau Dayal Institute of Vocational Education organized a webinar on Data Science in collaboration with Coding Blocks, highlighting applications of descriptive, diagnostic, predictive, and prescriptive analytics. The University also partnered with DRDO and the Department of Zoology to conduct a two-day workshop on Intellectual Property: Capturing, Acquisition, and Management of Portfolio (IP: CAMP), where experts from DRDO and industry engaged with faculty members and research scholars on IP acquisition and portfolio management. Such collaborations strengthen innovation ecosystems and enhance research commercialization capabilities.

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Entrepreneurship development is another key dimension of the University's partnership model. The Technology Based Entrepreneurship Development Program (TEDP) was organized in collaboration with MSME – Technology Development Centre and Central Footwear Training Institute, Agra, to train students under a Government entrepreneurship initiative, thereby fostering self-reliance and startup culture. Through such initiatives, the University supports industry linkages and promotes economic empowerment aligned with national development priorities.
