SDG 16 PEACE, JUSTICE AND STRONG INSTITUTIONS

Promote peaceful and inclusive societies for sustainable development, provide access to justice for all and build effective, accountable and inclusive institutions at all levels

SDG 16: Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions

“Sustainable Development Goal 16 aims to foster peaceful and inclusive societies for sustainable development; provide access to justice for all; and build effective, accountable and inclusive institutions at all levels.”

Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Agra (DBRAU) promotes peaceful and inclusive society, ensures equal access to justice, and fosters effective and accountable institutions. The university aims to promote integrity, inclusivity, and responsive government.

1. Accountable Governance

Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Agra values transparent governance and encourages all stakeholders, including students and professors, to actively participate in decision-making.

- **Policy Framework:** The university has publicly available policies to ensure transparency in administration, such as admission, fee refunds, performance appraisal, and resource use.
- **Code of Ethics:** DBRAU, Agra enforces a strict Code of Ethics policy and holds regular awareness sessions to reinforce professional ethics, integrity, accountability, and mutual respect among students and staff (e.g., in the School of Science & Technology and Clinical Research Departments).
- **Anti-Corruption Policies:** Condemnation, unfair means inquiry, and revised purchase policy are in place to ensure ethical and transparent financial and administrative procedures, reducing the danger of corruption and misbehaviour.

2. Access to Justice and Grievance Redressal Mechanisms

The university has put in place strong multi-level systems to facilitate timely and proper redressal of grievances to promote access to justice.

- **Students' Grievance Redressal Committee (SGRC):** Specific SGRCs are formed to oversee grievances of students pertaining to academics, administration, and evaluations based on the principles of natural justice.
- **Ombudsperson:** As per the guidelines of the UGC, an independent Ombudsperson (a retired District Judge) is appointed who hears and decides on the appeal against the decision of the SGRC to provide the last resort of impartial justice.

- **Zero Tolerance Policies**
 - **Anti-Ragging Policy:** DBRAU follows a strict zero-tolerance policy to maintain a ragging free campus through a separate committee and squad along with an open toll-free helpline number. The policy burdens the perpetrator with the proof while imposing strong collective punishment wherever needed.
 - **Internal Complaints Committee (ICC):** The ICC is responsible to deal with complaints related to Sexual Harassment.
- **Prevention of Plagiarism:** The Policy on Prevention of Plagiarism requires plagiarism detection tool to be used and makes IAIP responsible to maintain the academic integrity in all submissions.

3. Inclusive Institutions and Community Outreach Programs

The justice ideology of DBRAU is also found in the community outreach programs that are undertaken by the institute for developing inclusive societies and strong institutions from the ground up.

- **Inclusive Education:** Ensures equal access to education through policy initiatives for students from diverse backgrounds, policies related to accessibility and inclusion of physically challenged students, and cells for SC/ST/OBC/Minority students.
- **Rural Development Institute (RDI):** RDI of DBRAU has social welfare and community health programs. While these programs focus on health and education, they help develop trust between the institution and marginalized sections of society, thereby strengthening the institution itself.
- **Health and Social Justice:** Program interventions related to social justice issues such as gender-based violence and disability and rehabilitation.

4. Encouraging Research Ethics and Human Values

DBRAU places emphasis on development of ethical competence, especially in critical sectors such as clinical and medical research and creating integrity outside the university.

- **Ethics Committees:** There exist specific committees in the university such as the Ethics Committee and the Institutional Animal Ethics Committee (IAEC) which govern and regulate the ethical conduct of all research and processes within the university. More info at: DBRAU Ethics Committee

- **Bioethics and GCP Training:** DBRAU in partnership with the Department of Health Research (MoHFW) and ICMR Bioethics Unit undertakes regular training workshops on Good Clinical Practice (GCP) and Bioethics which improve ethical competencies of faculty members and Ethics Committee representatives of various medical colleges in the region.

- **Encouraging Human Values:** Sessions on “Human Values” are conducted to instill basic values of honesty, empathy, and integrity.

5. Curriculum Consistent with Goals of SDG 16

The curriculum consistency is geared towards fostering professionalism, respect for law, and good governance in:

- **Legal and ethical compliance:** Medical courses including forensic medicine & toxicology and allied health courses including medical physiotherapy law and ethics promote law and ethics in professional practice. Business courses also promote this through business laws, company law, and business ethics.
- **Good governance and accountability:** courses including Legal Implications in hospital administration, radiation safety & quality assurance, and various management subjects aim to create institutions that are transparent and effective in their actions.
- **Professional values and integrity:** various foundational and advanced courses cover topics such as professionalism and values and human values & professional ethics, providing students with fundamental principles needed for leadership in peaceful and just societies.
- **Safety and public order:** various courses such as the different radiation safety & quality assurance modules and Introduction to Forensic Nursing and Indian Laws help foster safety, security, and institutional strength for the protection of the public.

16.1 Research on Peace and Justice

Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar University (DBRAU), Agra is dedicated to the pursuit of research which fosters peace, justice, inclusiveness, and institutions as per SDG16. The university emphasizes research across various disciplines to address issues that arise in society today, such as governance, constitutional values, human rights, legal research, public policy, ethics, social justice, gender equality, public health, and institutional accountability. Research at DBRAU helps to foster democratic values, uphold the rule of law, protect vulnerable groups, and create efficient institutions.

The research conducted by the university also deals with important social problems like violence, discrimination, mental well-being, social inclusion, and community well-being. Through academic excellence, ethical research practices, and cooperation with government agencies, judiciary, health sector institutions, and communities, DBRAU endeavours to conduct research that contributes to public policy, welfare, and justice for all. The research efforts make a significant contribution towards building more safe, resilient, and inclusive communities and, at the same time, emphasize the commitment of the university towards peace, human dignity, and sustainable development.

Moreover, DBRAU fosters a culture of research integrity, ethical leadership, and community engagement through scholarly publication, collaboration, and interdisciplinary research. The research conducted at the university helps in evidence-based decision-making and development of institutions for better governance and social change. The research performance of the university related to SDG 16 is depicted through the scholarly publication, Cite Score, and Field-Weighted Citation Impact (FWCI) of the university.

16.1.1 Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions: Cite Score

The Cite Scores of journals in which research conducted by Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar University (DBRAU) on SDG 16 is published, signifies the level of recognition, scientific quality, and impact of the research work done by the university. Articles have been written on a variety of topics including peace, justice, governance, constitutional values, human rights, law, policy studies, ethics, inclusion, and institution-building, which have been published in various peer reviewed journals having Cite Scores. The higher Cite Score journals signify scientific recognition and dissemination of research, whereas publication in specialized journals help in

solving regional and social issues. Overall, the research work done by the university signifies their focus on producing quality research that adds to knowledge and helps in building strong institutions. (Refer to Table 2)

16.1.2 Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions: Field-Weighted Citation Impact (FWCI)

The Field Weighted Citation Impact (FWCI) is a standardized indicator of the global scientific influence of the research conducted by Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar University (DBRAU) that measures how the citations received by its publications compare to the world average for similar publications. The SDG 16 related publications from the university are scholarly influential and cover several topics associated with peace, justice, good governance, human rights, ethics, public policies, and institution building. Publications that have high FWCI have high international visibility and reputation, while those having moderate citation impact make significant contributions to the regional and national problems based on the results of empirical research. FWCI demonstrates the quality and importance of DBRAU's research in the context of SDG 16. (Refer to Table 2)

16.1.3 Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions: Publications

The research portfolio of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar University (DBRAU), Agra demonstrates the university's sustained commitment to advancing the objectives of Sustainable Development Goal 16 through evidence-based, multidisciplinary scholarship. The publications presented in Table 2 collectively address diverse aspects of peace, justice, governance, constitutional values, human rights, public policy, ethics, gender equality, public health, legal studies, and institutional development. Together, these research outputs contribute to a deeper understanding of contemporary societal challenges while providing scientific evidence that supports transparent governance, inclusive decision-making, equitable access to justice, and the protection of vulnerable communities. The inclusion of bibliometric indicators such as Cite Score, Field-Weighted Citation Impact (FWCI), citation count, and persistent identifiers (DOI/URL) further demonstrates the quality, visibility, and scholarly influence of these publications. Collectively, this body of research reflects DBRAU's contribution to strengthening peaceful, inclusive, and accountable institutions at regional, national, and global levels in alignment with the objectives of SDG 16. 16.2 University Governance Measures

Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar University (DBRAU), Agra, is governed in the framework of a participatory governance model through its statutory authorities, which guarantee transparency, accountability, and representation of stakeholders. DBRAU publishes notifications about the composition and members of these statutory bodies regularly, providing transparency within the organization. Besides these authorities, several statutory and advisory committees, including the Finance Committee, Court Committee, Student Council, Internal Complaints Committee, Anti-Ragging Committee, and other governing committees have been established by DBRAU to ensure participatory administration.
